USHERING INSTRUCTIONS FOR B'NAI MITZVAH FAMILIES

Shalom b'nai mitzvah families,

Please make sure your calendars are marked for the date your family is responsible for ushering duties. As a reminder, **your family ushers at the b'nai mitzvah ceremony immediately preceding yours.**

On your morning, **you will arrive at 10am and stand at the entrance to the sanctuary.** As the face of Temple Beth-El that morning, **you are our ambassadors.** Please be sure to:

- **wish everyone a friendly Shabbat shalom as you hand them a siddur (blue book)**
- **offer them a chumash (red book)**
- **give them information they need (directions to the bathroom, where to hang their coats, handicapped entrance, miscellaneous Temple info.)**

Of course, Tom Rosensweet and/or other board members are also on hand, so feel free to go to them with any questions you may not know how to answer.
